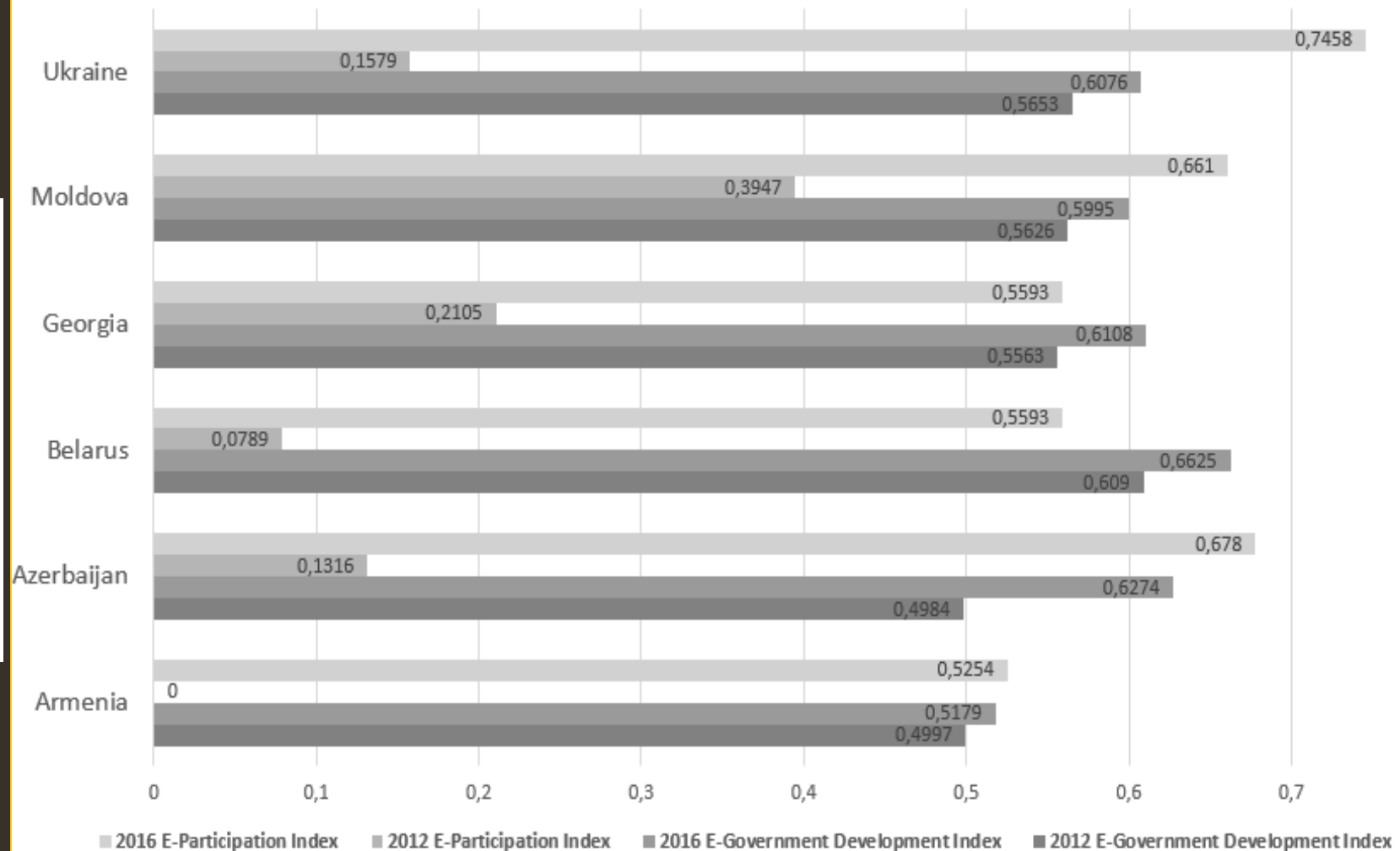
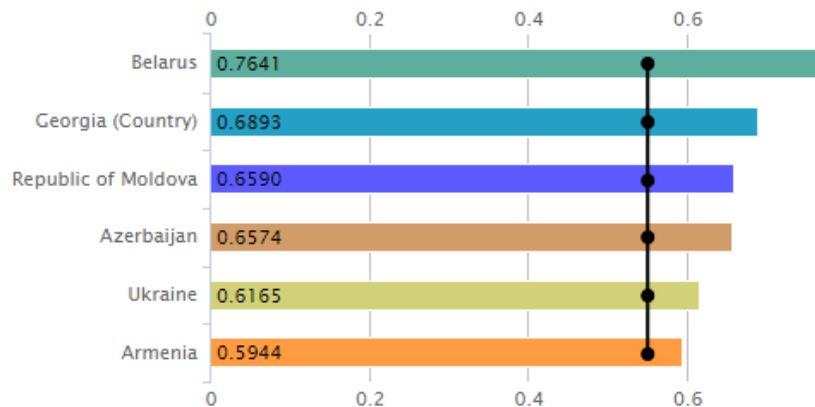

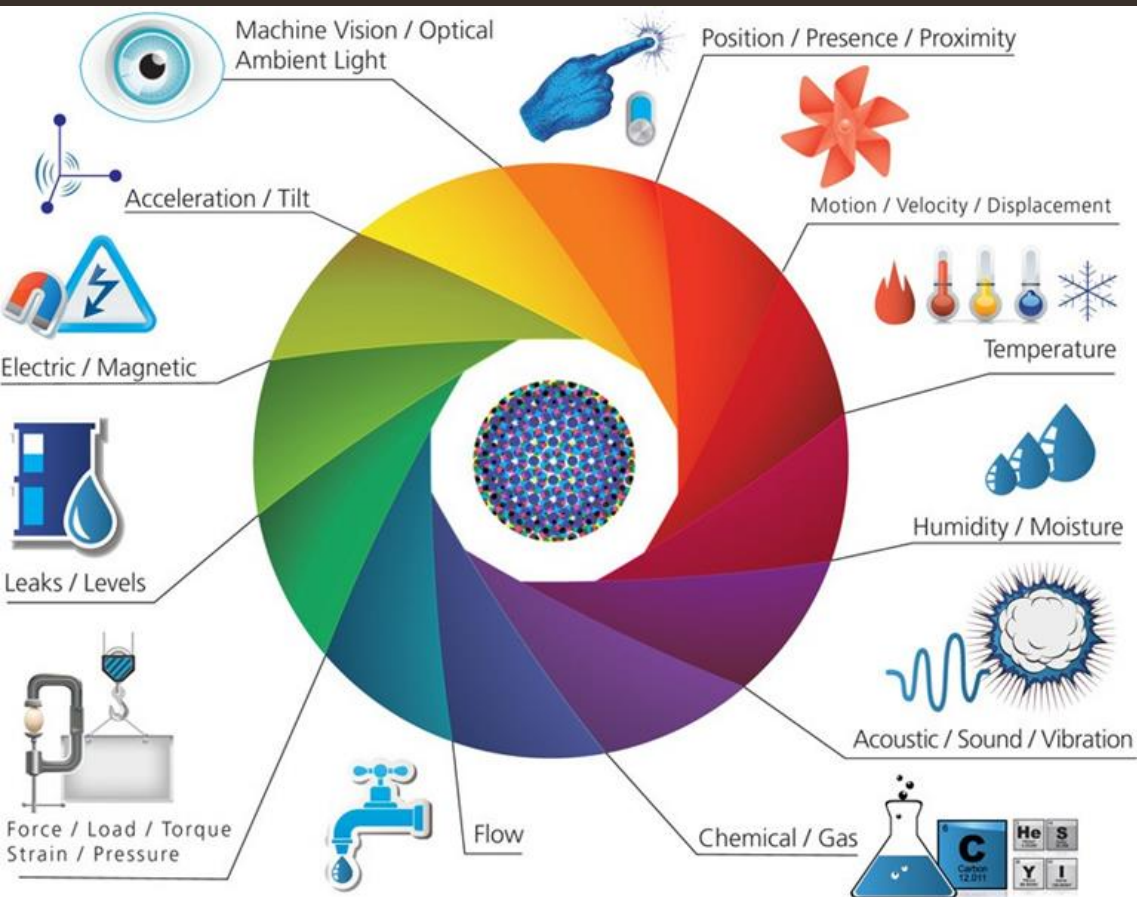
2018 E-Government Development Index

● World Average

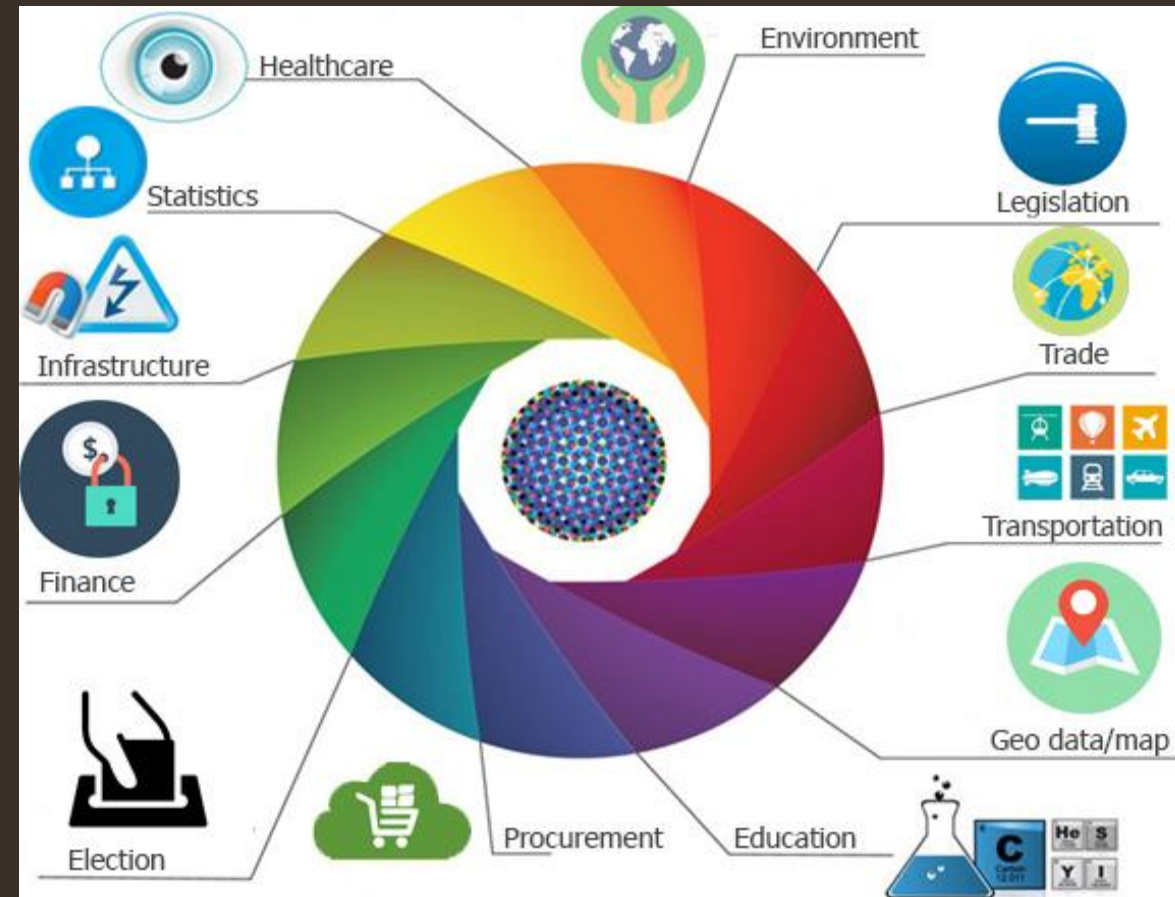
